By leaving a gift in your will you will be helping to transform lives after your death. Through your donation more people will discover the life-changing gift of retreats.

Ways to leave a gift

You can leave a gift for the Retreat Association in a number of ways:

- **A specific gift** – where you leave a specific item (such as jewellery, stocks and shares).
- **A pecuniary gift** – where you specify the amount that you'd like to go to the charity.
- **A residuary gift** – this is the remainder of your estate once any specific gifts have been made to friends and family, or a percentage of it.

- **working** alongside organisations who share the same vision.


Who comes to us for help?*

**These are fictional examples of some of our most common enquiries.*

How will a gift make a difference?
